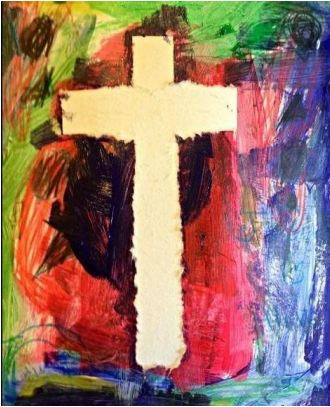

All are welcome to join us in downtown Fargo for the 20 minute practice of centering prayer in community. Centering Prayer is a receptive method of silent prayer in which we experience God's presence within us, closer than breathing, closer than thinking, closer than consciousness itself. This method of prayer is both a relationship with God and a practice to foster a relationship with the Divine within us. The simple guidelines will be covered before the practice with time for questions and connections after.
